What is CSA?

CSA means: Community Supported Agriculture. It means that a farmer commits to producing a variety of seasonal vegetables in return for your prepaid commitment to season-long purchase and pick-up of these fresh veggies for your family.

CSA creates a “2-way” street. Your membership helps pay for seed, equipment, fuel, irrigation and labor. In return, members receive small fruit and vegetables, farm fresh, each week. We all share in the risks and the benefits of farming.

When you purchase a full share in our summer C.S.A., a 1/2 bushel box of seasonal produce will be grown, picked, packed and reserved for you each week for ten weeks, starting around Mid-June. Full share cost is \$300.00. Half shares (delivery every other week) are available for \$175.00. Two families may share a Full share (\$300 total). \$100.00 deposit due at sign-up. Pick-up times and sites will be announced. Balance due at first pick-up.

What's in your garden?

Beans, broccoli, cabbage, cantaloupe, carrots, cauliflower, collards, corn, cucumber, eggplant, fennel, field peas, greens, gourds, herbs, kale, leeks, lettuce, melons, mustard, okra, onions, peas, hot peppers, sweet peppers, potatoes, pumpkins, radish, spinach, squash, strawberries, sunflowers, Swiss chard, tomatoes, turnips, flowers – cut for bouquets, edible, or dried.



Of course, crops are seasonal (and Mother Nature bats last, as every farmer knows), so don't expect everything all at once. Additional quantities may be purchased, when available, for canning, juicing or drying. (making wine!!!)

Buy Locally and Seasonally

- We also love to eat what we grow.
- Locally grown food tastes better and is more nutritious. It ripened on the plant, not in a truck. We know where our veggies spent last night.
- Imported foods do not have the same safety standards as food grown in the U.S.A.
